Born in 1934, studied English at Beijing Foreign Language Institute and then graduated at Karl-Marx-University in Leipzig, Ambassador Mei Zhaorong started his diplomatic career in 1956.

Ambassador Mei served as Director General of the Department of West-European Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from 1985 to 1988, and the Ambassador to Germany from 1988 to 1997. He was the President of the Chinese People's Institute of Foreign Affairs from 1997 to 2003. Ambassador Mei is also a member of the 8<sup>th</sup> National Committee of the Chinese Peoples' Political Consultative Conference from 1993 to 1998.

Ambassador Mei is now the Executive Director of Strategic Study Centre of China Foundation for International Studies, Vice Chairman of China Institute of International Strategic Studies, Director of the Institute of World Development and Research Centre of the State Council.

Ambassador Mei translated a number of German Books into Chinese and is the author of dozens of articles analyzing or commenting on European affairs and international relations.
